Introduction

KUSHT NIYANTRAN EVUM UNMOOLAN SAMITI (KNEUS) is a registered voluntary organization working for Leprosy, HIV/AIDs, Tuberculosis and other communicable diseases in the states of Uttar Pradesh and Delhi for almost three decades. KNEUS is not just one of the leading organizations working in the field of T.B, and also searches to find T.B, HIV affected area through survey. Our mission started in the year 1987, KNEUS, rendered service in 57 leprosy colonies in the western UP and treated over 5,000 leprosy patients and their children are helped to gain education in order to stand on their own feet. in different fields.

KNEUS at present works with 2 DMCs under RNTCP project NGO/Private Provider/PPP Partner in 2003 in urban slums and remote areas. KNEUS is providing holistic treatment and care for people affected by Tuberculosis & HIV and also providing Primary health care to the surrounding areas. We are rendering service in the middle of urban and migrant people who are living under poverty line. It has adopted a holistic approach in tackling the diseases through counselling, advocacy and envisaging the welfare of those affected. The challenges associated with this pandemic still continue as the virus is still virulent and engulfing lives. It has been tough especially for people with T.B and marginalized, many have lost the livelihood, job, carriers and the students discontinued their studies. And this pandemic worsens the lives of them and there is increase numbers of T.B patients in the same family due to the Poverty.

The COVID-19 pandemic brought about untold misery to a large part of the population in India with people losing homes, jobs, their family members. In times of this crisis KNEUS responded to this by ensuring ration and medicines for the Tuberculosis affected. The challenges associated with this pandemic still continue as the virus is still virulent and engulfing lives.

In spite of the pandemic the committed staff responded to the humanitarian needs and went out of the way to ensure that the Tuberculosis affected and others too could lead a somewhat decent life in this turbulent time.

Now KNEUS is having two DMCs in Noida (From Sector 1 to Sector 17 it covers) & Salarpur (Now it is shifted to Surajpur) district Gautam Buddh Nagar and the head office facilitated with Dispensary, fully equipped Pathology lab, physiotherapy, TB Care, Therapeutic & rehabilitation for differently abled children and rehabilitation towards bright future- educational support to children of leprosy affected family.

KNEUS renders its services through various approaches and efforts for better healthcare services in the underprivileged society. KNEUS also has sample collection centers which have been placed at Sector-10, Noida and Salarpur. So that more and more needy people can get better service. This Pathology Lab provides unparalleled quality services to our clients. Various types of tests and molecular diagnostics in the lab, serology, immunochemistry, PCR techniques, infectious diseases, biochemistry, hematology, etc. Provided under the supervision of experienced personnel and pathologists. KNEUS has been organizing Free Health Check-up Camps to raise mass awareness about health and the importance of regular health check-ups. A collection center is a place where a customer walks in and gives his sample with belief and confidence in KNEUS's accuracy and efficiency. Support Towards Tuberculosis Elimination

Kusht Niyantran Evum Unmoolan Samiti (KNEUS) started its collaboration with the Revised National Tuberculosis Control Program (RNTCP) project in the year 2003. Initially 9 Designated Microscopy Tuberculosis Treatment Centers were established with District Tuberculosis Officers in different districts. Due to indifferent attitude from the government, KNEUS closed 8 centers in 2016, only two centers are continuing in Gautam Buddha Nagar. The main objective of KNEUS is to provide TB test and treatment at the right time to all the poor and underprivileged people so that the risk of infection on the community around us can be reduced and eliminated. KNEUS is contributing towards the government's goal of a T.B.free India. KNEUS is providing our support on the following, points. Primary level health care, OPD-Daily Diagnosis, Pathology Lab, Designated Microscopy Centre-Sputum tests of the suspected patients., DOTs Centre-Monitoring of the treatments-Daily Regimen., Enrolment and follow up of TB patients under Nikshay., Counselling & Refer of patients to ICTC Centre for HIV/AIDS test., Address verification of the registered patients through home visits by health workers., All those patients are referred for HIV test and counseling who are diagnosed as T.B. and Diabetic test, treatment हलाज ही अगर छोड़ देंगे and follow-up is done for all those patients who are टीबी को कै से हरायेंची प diagnosed as TB.

Educational Support To Children from Leprosy Affected family

Leprosy is, unlike most other contagious diseases, an illness which arouses not only fear of infection, but also horror and disgust – leading to aversion and social ostracism. This unique reaction is called the stigma of leprosy. The stigma attached to leprosy is so acute that persons affected by the disease, in many cases, are forced to leave their homes and live in isolated colonies. Even those who live within society are often excluded from participating in the mainstream society. They are often ostracised and prevented from accessing community resources, like water from community wells, and are excluded from festivals and community gatherings. They are denied education, employment and often lose the freedom to marry a 'normal' person. The stigma and discrimination extends to the family well. Members are treated in a similar way and not allowed to participate in the society. So, many families reject the person affected by leprosy for fear of exclusion, thus leaving them without family, home and social support networks. Many Leprosy affected family in north India

live in a colonies which are known as leprosy colony. They have no land, no employment and no any job except begging. They have a serious problem of giving better education to their children. The children of these families also facing social stigma and discrimination in the surrounding.

In order to education is a basic human right for all children KUSHT NIYANTRAN EVUM UNMOOLAN SAMITI is sponsoring 12 (children from leprosy affected families) admission in LKG to 12th standard and providing qualitative boarding education with the support of Fr. Agnel School, Greater Noida.

They were unable to work and generate income for livelihood. So, I could not thought about education. And other cause of attached social stiama and discrimination was a big barrier of my education as well as life. 

So, transparent hands provide the importance of and objectives of the medical camp free medical advice, medicine to the unfortunate people and refer them for specialized treatment whenever it is required. These camps make sure people are getting the healthcare at the right time, and seeing the doctor early enough before a small health problem turns serious.

Medical camps are conducted by health professionals to carry out a limited health intervention amongst the underprivileged community. The poor attend these camps to get free check-up and treatment. Getting the appropriate kind of health check-up is vital for every human being and while considering it, some important factors like age, lifestyle, habits, family background and risk are taken into account.

Health examinations and tests at the early stages the illness can help to cure it faster and save a life before it can cause any damage. One can live longer and healthier only when the individual gets the right kind of health checkups, screening and treatment. Even the most basic checkups can identify underlying illness.


