### **BACKGROUND INFORMATION**

KUSHT NIYANTRAN EVUM UNMOOLAN SAMITI (KNEUS) is a registered voluntary organization working for Leprosy, HIV/AIDs, Tuberculosis and other communicable diseases in the states of Uttar Pradesh, Uttarkhand and Delhi for almost two decades. In the year 1987, KNEUS started working in 57 leprosy colonies in the western UP and treated over 5,000 leprosy patients. In 1992, this work was extended to villages and cities, where through house to house surveys and health education programs patients were detected and treated. The leprosy focused services carried out by the organization have been extended to tuberculosis after integration of leprosy treatment into general health in 2003. The systematic and scientific approach planned and implemented by KNEUS has yielded desired result several folds. This is evident from the fact that nearly 47,394 number of medical interventions for leprosy affected persons and 24,324 number of tuberculosis affected persons have been undertaken by the organization as on December 2014.

## **Tuberculosis**

India has the highest burden of Tuberculosis in the world, accounting for approximately one fifth of the global incidence – an estimated 2 million cases annually. TB is a curable and preventable disease and yet it causes significant morbidity and mortality, which is a cause of serious concern. The Revised National Tuberculosis Control Program has completed 15 years of its implementation with four years of full nation-wide coverage. Since its inception in the districts of GauthamBudh Nagar, Ghaziabad, JyotibaPhule Nagar, Bijnor, Jhansi, Jaunpur, Maharajganj and Haridwar by Kusht Niyantran Evum Unmoolan Samiti the program has initiated over 24,324 patients on treatment thus saving more than 3 lakh lives. In 2003, when the program was initiated in Bijnor and GauthamBudh Nagar districts, KNEUS registered 167 patients and put them on DOTs. Today the program has achieved the global targets of 70% case detection and 85% cure rates in new smear positive patients in the project areas. These are encouraging trends for RNTCP as it steadily works towards achieving the

Millennium Development Goals by 2015. The ultimate goal of the program remains a "TB-free India", and clearly it is a long journey towards this goal.

KNEUS has 9 Designated Microscopic Centers (DMCs) of Revised National Tuberculosis Control Program (RNTCP) under Public Private Partnership with the Government of U.P. and U.K. in Bhangel and Sec-10 of GautamBudh Nagar,Khora of Ghaziabad,Baghera of Jhansi,Pariyat of Jaunpur,Sinduria of Maharajganj,Saidnagali ofJ.P.Nagar,Mandawali of Bijnor and Jagjeetpur of Haridwar district.Most of the population living in the three urban DMCs,Bhangel,Sec-10 and Khoraareas is migrants and unauthorized settlement consists of more than 1lakhs.





They are socially, economically backward and marginalized. Health facilities in this area are very pathetic. People are suffering due to lack of basic civil facilities. The population of this area cannot be accurately censured because of the frequent in and out of people from this area. The development of women and children residing in the target area are in risk due to lack of health and educational facilities. Majority of the population belongs to lower class. The living condition is also pathetic. Half of the children in this area below 14 yrs are going for work. And 6 DMC Baghera, Pariyat, Sinduria, Saidnagali, Mandawali and Jagjeetpur are covering very remote of the rural area. There are lack of health facilities and awareness.

### KNEUS PROJECT AREA WHERE PERFORMING RNTCP ACTIVITIES



All 9 KNEUS DMCs are working for the health care of the people residing in the area since 2003. It has a long history of supporting health services at the community level, often with remarkable effectiveness and rapport with communities. KNEUS also have capacity to provide excellent treatment support, counseling for patients, and contributes to public health oriented activities in TB treatment, namely address verification and default retrieval. Through these centers free sputum checkup and medicines are given to the people those who are suffering from tuberculosis, leprosy and other communicable diseases. Majority of the population approaching this centre are below poverty line. The staffs in this centre are giving health education to the people. The District Health Society was providing training and technical guidance and performs laboratory quality control. They monitor diagnostic quality (three smears taken for diagnosis and two for follow-up, proportion of positive smears, and proportion of smear—negative cases, if any).

Ever since KNEUS signed Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with District Tuberculosis Officer (DTO) on behalf of District Health Society (DHS) on 29.10.2003 it has registered and treated 24,324 Tuberculosis patients so far in this colony and villages till 2014 December. Year- wise details are given below.



## WORLD TB DAY CELEBRATION BY KNEUS COLLABRATION WITH ORDER DE MALTE FRANCE IN INDIA ON 24th MARCH 2015

World TB Day falling on 24 March each year, is designed to build public awareness that tuberculosis today remains an epidemic in much of the world, causing the deaths of several million people each year, mostly in the third world. 24 March commemorates the day in 1882 when Dr. Robert Koch astounded the scientific community by announcing that he had discovered the cause of tuberculosis, the TB bacillus. Koch's discovery opend the way toward diagnosing and curing tuberculosis, so this day is celebrated as World TB Day. Tuberculosis, or TB, is an infectious bacterial disease caused by Mycobacterium tuberculosis, which most commonly affects the lungs. It is transmitted from person to person via droplets from the throat and lungs of people with the disease.
